Yearly membership is from September 1st to August 31st. All subscriptions include affiliation fees and levies to Auckland Tennis and New Zealand Tennis, court key, clubhouse key (seniors and midweek only), coaching programme (juniors, intermediates and seniors) and GST. Fees can be paid by cash, cheque or direct credit to ASB 12 3082 0079878 00 (use player's full name as reference). Our club coach is available for private lessons.

Court Bookings

It is always advisable to book a court if you wish to play in the evenings, especially during the Spring/Summer season. The booking sheet is located in the Clubhouse. Please ensure that you cancel any bookings for courts no longer required in good time so that courts can be re-booked. Courts may be booked for a maximum of one hour. Members may continue to play after this time only if there is no one waiting to use the courts.

Juniors have the use of the courts Monday to Friday after school until 5.30pm, except where the Junior programme is operating (see Junior notice board for times).

Visitors are welcome. The following policy applies in respect of visitors:

- First three visits are free
- After three visits:
 - \$10 per person per visit for use of the tennis courts outside of organised tennis times (Senior, Midweek)
 - \$25 per person per visit for attending organised Senior or Midweek sessions.
- No lights.

The club expects that after three visits, a visitor will become a financial member, or pay the fees outlined above. Club members are responsible for collecting visitor's fees.

Tennis Attire

Appropriate tennis attire only is to be worn at all club days and when representing the Club at interclub and other tennis events. No casual wear, e.g. beachwear, T-shirts, or beach baggies.

No black soled sports shoes or shoes with rubber sprigs to be worn on the courts.
